Thank you for your interest in The Kevin E. Reichardt Scholar-Athlete Championship Fund Scholarship. The mission of the Kevin Reichardt Foundation has been to keep Kevin's spirit alive by awarding scholarships to deserving students. The \$4,000 scholarship will go to a graduating high school senior, male or female. It will be a one-time award, payable to an accredited college in two payments, one in the fall and the second in the spring. A 3.0 Grade Point Average must be attained in the first semester (fall) in order to be eligible to receive the final award.

The criteria is as follows: GPA minimum is a 3.3 and financial need. The candidate must be a Varsity Lacrosse player with the intention of playing in college. He, or she, must be able to substantiate outstanding leadership qualities and character. It is the intent of the award to be supplemental to any other scholarships or grants already available to the student. It is not intended to replace existing scholarships offered by colleges or other agencies. We will interview the final applicants either by phone or in person. The application must be postmarked by April 1, and the award will be announced in May. Please forward the completed application with all required documentation to the Kevin E. Reichardt Foundation, P.O. Box 6055, Annapolis, Maryland 21401.

The scholarship awarded from this fund will recognize students who exemplify Kevin by excelling in the classroom, surpassing expectations on the playing field and leading others with focused initiative. General Information:

- TENURE-The Scholarship is a one time award to be paid in two installments, one in the fall and the other in the spring. A 3.0 GPA is required for release of the 2nd installment.
- Students must be enrolled in an accredited college or university and carry a minimum of twelve (12) semester hours, both semesters.
- All checks for scholarships are made payable only to the college or the university. The first check will be sent to the college in August.
- A student leaving college shall forfeit the scholarship.

The student holding The Kevin E. Reichardt Scholarship must report by letter before the commencement of the spring semester, enclosing transcript of fall semester grades before the spring semester's check will be issued. A 3.0 Grade Point Average must be attained in the first semester (fall) in order to be eligible to receive
